Welcome!

Montessori in the City, Inc. has operated this school since February, 1999. Our goal is to create a wonderful learning environment for the children who attend our school. We hold several events during the school year and summer program to keep our families in contact with the school and the teachers. We feel that it is important to keep parents involved in all of our school events. This brings a sense of cohesion and commitment, along with dedication, within our school.

Our relationships with the children, parents and our staff are the key components for a quality school. The Montessori philosophy is based on encouraging children to feel important, self-reliant and independent in a nurturing environment. We feel that the outdoor environment is very important to the child. Our outdoor play yards are specifically tailored to meet the needs of each age group. Our yards include several activities including the climbing gym and slide, sandbox and several riding toys. Also, when the weather is appropriate, the children get to enjoy water play and gardening. The indoor environment focuses on the academics and exhibits order, concentration, coordination and independence. The classroom gives the children a sense of pride and responsibility. Each child is able to progress at his or her own pace when working with the materials in the classroom.

Our staff includes teachers, a chef, administrators and substitute teachers. Each teacher has a minimum of 12 ECE units and/or Montessori training, or an AA or BA. Our school chef prepares homemade meals in the kitchen daily. We use processed foods

minimally, using only the freshest ingredients in most of our snacks and meals. We puree fruits and vegetables and freeze them for our infants as well. We serve breakfast, lunch and two snacks daily. We believe in nutrition for a happy, healthy child. As the children get older, we also believe in serving meals and snack family style. This gives the child the opportunity to serve themselves their snacks and their meals. It teaches them independence, manners and responsibility.

The school office has an open door policy. Even if the door is closed, please knock if you need to speak with us. The staff is also available to help you with questions at any time. We print a monthly newsletter to keep you informed of activities and special events that happen each month.

We are happy to have you as a part of our Montessori family. If you are not enrolled in the center at this time, we hope that you will have the opportunity to be part of our Montessori family in the future.

What is Montessori?

Founder of the educational philosophy which still bears her name today, Dr. Maria Montessori (1870 – 1952), was the first woman ever granted a degree by an Italian university. Through her extensive work with children she became interested in the effects of educational concept on the total development of the child. Her comprehensive research resulted in a concept of the “whole child” education through the use of self-correcting, manipulative materials.

Why Montessori?

Montessori principles and materials have been incorporated into schools of many types and levels from infancy through college courses, yet Montessori is a separate, unique educational experience for the young child. Children in the Montessori class work in a carefully prepared environment that stimulates learning and discovery in a happy, independent manner. Each child, following his or her own time clock, can progress as rapidly as individual ability allows. The Montessori philosophy provides a success oriented environment that actually motivates learning!

Children attending our school have the opportunity to be exposed to the advantages

of the Montessori environment on many levels of learning. Preschool and toddler children work in carefully prepared classrooms fully equipped with Montessori materials and extensions. Each class is directed by an individual trained in Early Childhood Montessori Education.

Lincoln Plaza Montessori provides homemade meals for the children every day. We also provide diapers and wipes. Parents are only required to bring in formula or breast milk.
